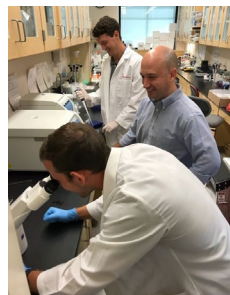

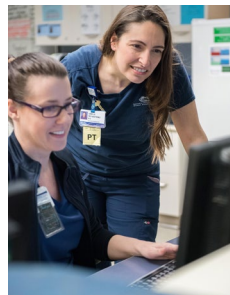
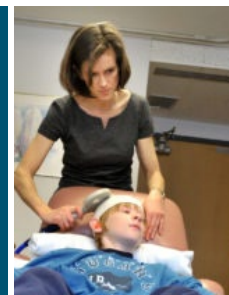

In 2017, the Academy expanded research funding through this fund to also support post-doctoral students

The Foundation anticipates to fund a Pediatric-funded PODS I scholarship every year and a grant every other year.

Current Budget Status

2023

Projected Income: \$2,605,600

Projected Expenses: \$2,897,291

Potential loss = **\$291,691**

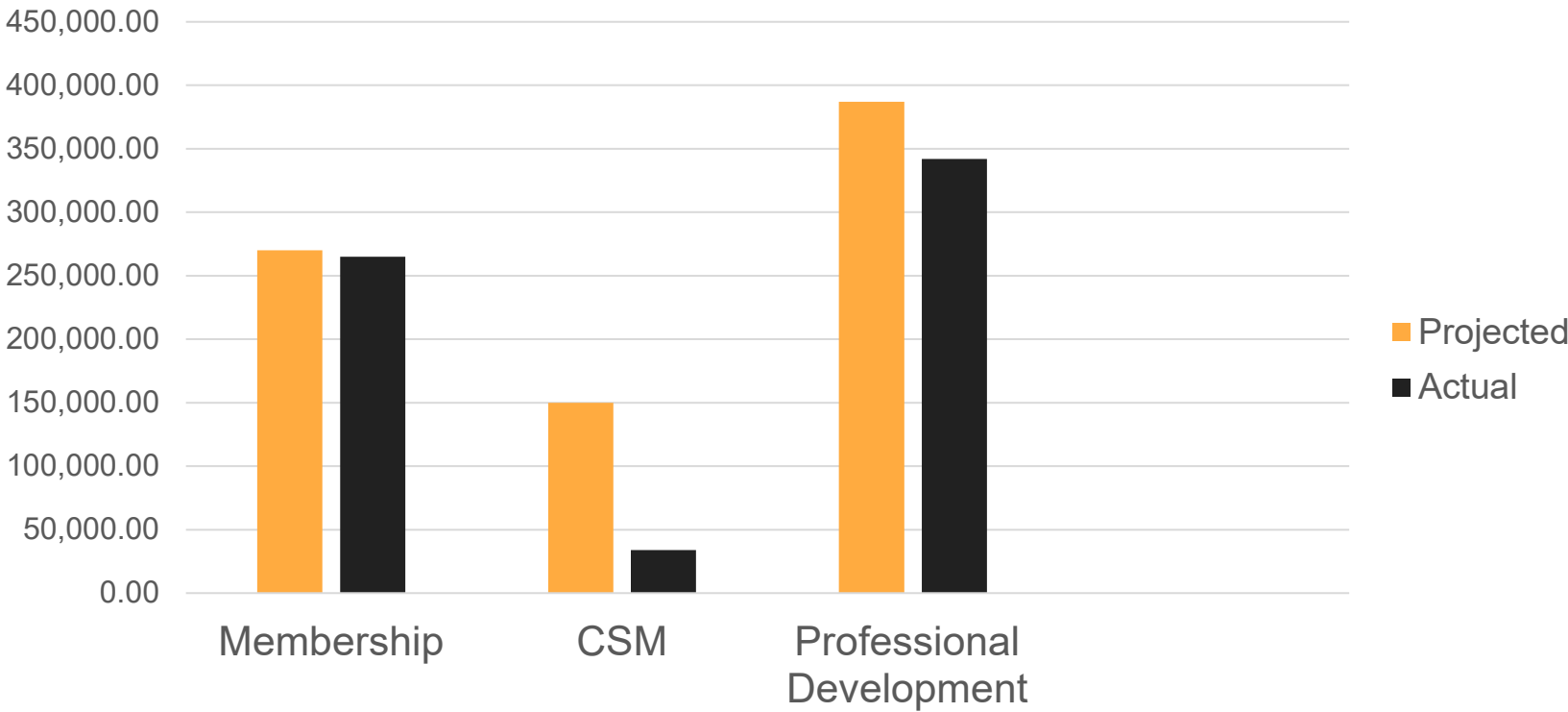
Primary source of income (historically) has been:

- Membership
- Professional Development Courses

- Professional Course Attendance

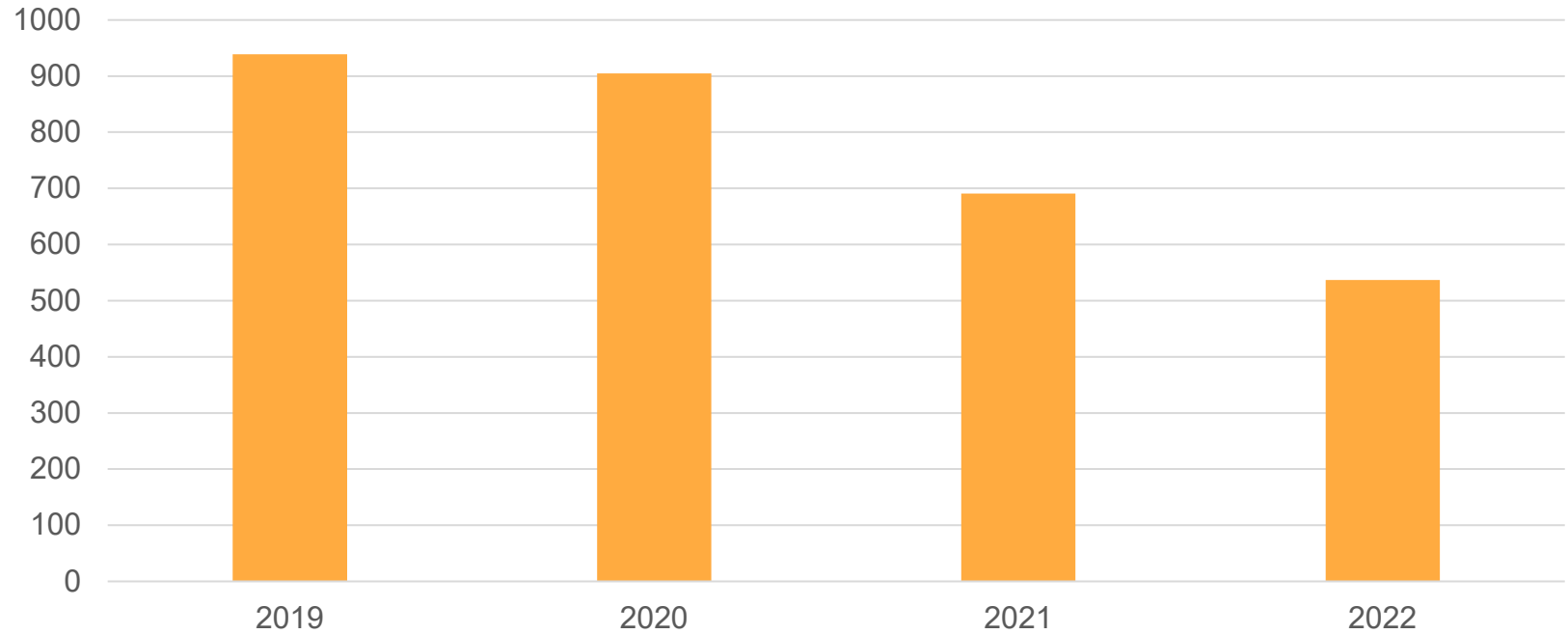
Decrease in all incoming revenue over past 2+ years
