# Service Awards



## **Jeanne Fischer Distinguished Mentorship Award**

Recognizes sustained, altruistic mentorship beyond that expected within the nominee's regular employment.

## **Lynn M Jeffries, PT, DPT, PhD**

Lynn is Associate Professor and Vice Chair in the Department of Rehabilitation Science at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center in Oklahoma City and an International Collaborator for the CanChild Centre for Childhood Disability Research. Her research interests include outcomes for children with cerebral palsy and school based physical therapy services. Dr Jeffries serves as the Vice President of APTA Pediatrics and has held many elected positions at the state and national levels of the profession. Her passion is mentorship and advising new professionals.



## **Susan Effgen Advocacy Award**

Recognizes consistent support for the delivery of pediatric physical therapy services via advocacy for or participation in legislation, policies, and/or procedures at the regional, state, or national level.

## **Durga Shah, PT, DPT, PCS**

Durga is a practicing pediatric board-certified clinical specialist at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. She has an appointment as Assistant Clinical Professor at Emory University in Atlanta, GA and teaches pediatric content at entry and elective levels. Dr Shah has extensive experience in clinical pediatric settings in acute care, outpatient rehab, specialty clinics and global health/education. Throughout her career Dr Shah has advocated for changes in policies that support physical therapy services for children.




